CANSKATE

- Season runs from Sep 19 to Mar 9
- Saturday sessions start Oct 14 and end Mar 9

Learn-to-Skate ("CanSkate")

- For children ages 3 years and up
- Focus on basic skating skills to complete Skate Canada CanSkate Badges 1 to 6
- Good for hockey, ringette and figure skating
- Includes 10 minutes of warm-up, 30-minute group lesson & 5 minutes of cool down

Intro to Figure Skating ("Intro")

- Must have passed CanSkate Badge 3 or at coach's discretion
- Advanced CanSkate program for skaters interested in pursuing figure skating
- Focus on various skating elements, like spins, jumps, edges and turns to complete CanSkate badges 4 to 6
- Two-day program includes group lessons with the option to arrange a private lesson during the session, with a Club coach for an additional fee

STARSKATE

- Season runs from Sep 5 to Mar 28
- Saturday sessions start Oct 14 and end Mar 9
- Offers development in fundamental figure skating skills in the areas of ice dance, skating skills, freeskate and artistic skating
- Skaters are evaluated through Skate Canada's nationally standardized testing system from Star 1 to 10 plus Gold in the various areas
- Requires arrangement of group and/or private lessons with a Club coach (these fees are not included in registration fees)
- A current listing of Club coaches can be found on our website

Junior

- Passed CanSkate Stage 6 or at coach's discretion.

Intermediate

- Passed Star 2 Freeskate or at coach's discretion.

Senior

- Passed Star 4 or 5 Freeskate or at coach's discretion.

* Registration is ongoing throughout the season but some sessions fill quickly. Register early to get your preferred sessions!

CLUB RULES

- CSA-approved hockey helmet and gloves/mittens must be worn by all CanSkate participants up to and including Stage 5. Bicycle or other helmets are not allowed.
- Skaters under the age of 12 must have a parent or guardian in the arena at all times during sessions.
- Skaters are to use assigned dressing rooms
- Parents and/or non-member skaters are not allowed on the ice during sessions
- There are no make-up days due to illness, vacations, or conflicting events
- Please contact coaches off the ice, not during group or private lessons
- The number of skaters allowed at one time on all sessions shall be limited
- The Club reserves the right to adjust, cancel, or reschedule sessions should it be deemed necessary
- Refund requests will only be considered for medical or exceptional reasons and must be made in writing along with supporting documents. The Board reserves the right to deny refunds.
- Skate Canada/Admin Fee is non-refundable or transferrable. Additional administrative fees may also apply to cancelled memberships.
